



# LA MATHESON SECONDARY ATHLETICS STUDENT-ATHLETE'S CODE OF CONDUCT

The actions of a student-athlete are a reflection of themselves, their team, their school and their community. A student's involvement in school sport provides opportunities and experiences that are important to the development of a well-rounded student. However, student-athletes must remember that their participation in school sport is a privilege, not a right.

In order to maintain their athletic eligibility with their team, student-athletes shall:

## TREAT EVERYONE WITH RESPECT

- Treat teammates, coaches, opponents, event organizers, spectators, and school staff with respect
- Respect and accept with dignity the decisions of officials
- Be generous in winning and graceful in losing

## EXERCISE SELF-CONTROL AT ALL TIMES

- Refrain from the use of foul or profane language
- Refrain from the use of physical force outside the rules of the game
- Refrain from the use and involvement of drugs or alcohol

## PLAY FAIR

- Play within the rules and the spirit of the rules of the game at all times

As a member of an LA Matheson team I understand and agree to abide by the set of standards outlined in the Code of Conduct. Upon Violation of the any of the standards, while as a member of the team or while attending a school function I understand that I may be suspended from the team by the coach, Athletic Director or School Administration. Possible further consequences may include:

- suspension from the team for the remainder of the season
- suspension from all athletics for the remainder of the season
- possible suspension from school
